

Judges Tips

Section A: Cut Flowers

Collection: a container with stems of different colours or varieties not arranged.
Container used to hold entry is not judged

Section B: Roses

Singly Staged: each rose is displayed in a vase/bottle of its own. Vase/bottle are provided by the show for these categories. For example B7: 3 dark roses. To be presented each rose of the 3 roses will be displayed individual in its own vase, lined up together

The ideal rose should have no blemishes or damage to petals

Section C: Cut Flowers

For all of section C1 the container/vase used is considered part of the judged arrangement

C1.1 Table centre piece. Low enough for dinner guests to be able to see those sitting on the opposite side of the table, or can be tall and slender, able to see under the arrangement.

C1.3 Immersed in water means covered by water not floated on top of water.

C1.4 Miniature vase of miniature flowers must be less than 8-10cm total in height (including flowers)

C1.6 Arrangement incorporating wood should include a good balance between wood and flowers/foilage

C1.9 Jug of mixed flowers a neat arrangement with good height is preferred

Floral Saucer saucer plate should be covered/filled with flowers/foilage limit gaps of sand/dirt that visible
